

## Special Exhibitions

Explore history, science, technology, and culture in ever-changing vibrant exhibitions that examine Texas history and the state's relationship to the world. In 2017–2018, the Museum features exhibitions about the history of electronic gaming, from Pong to Pokémon; prohibition's flappers, suffragists and notorious legends like Al Capone and Carrie Nation; the tradition of rodeo in Texas; and the paintings of Comanche artist and historian Eric Tippeconnic.



## Texas History Galleries

Visit galleries featuring hundreds of stories from the earliest inhabitants of the region to 21<sup>st</sup> century space exploration. Don't miss the 300-year-old ship, *La Belle*, and selections from the more than 1.5 million artifacts excavated when it was raised from the waters of Matagorda Bay. Discover the roots of the Texas Revolution, the road to statehood, and how Texas continues to influence the world.
