

WHO WE ARE:

PROTECT is a human trafficking prevention education & training program that was formed in 2015 by a coalition of three anti-trafficking nonprofits; 3Strands Global Foundation, Frederick Douglass Family Initiatives, and Love Never Fails. The program is now being implemented across the United States and has expanded to reach various school districts, community groups and professional industries with tools to recognize and prevent human trafficking.



THE ISSUE:

With technology being used as a deceptive gateway for exploiters to recruit and exploit children, the time is now for us to implement prevention education in the classroom. Signs of human trafficking can be difficult to recognize, so prevention training is more needed than ever.

THE SOLUTION:

PROTECT aims to reduce the vulnerability of youth by identifying and preventing human trafficking using a trauma-informed education curriculum and training for corporations and communities.
