Butterfly Kite Instructions

Materials you will need:

- Butterfly template printed on cardstock
- Crayons, markers or colored pencils
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Hole Punch
- String

Instructions:

1. Decorate your butterfly template with markers, crayons or colored pencils.
2. Fold your butterfly in half along the center line, with image on the inside of the fold.
3. Open your paper back up and now fold along the diagonal lines with the wings facing up.
4. Pinch the middle fold down and glue the insides of the fold. Now you have a kite that looks like the one in the photo above.
5. Use a hole punch to make a hole through the outside of the folded crease on the bottom of your kite where the black circles show through.
6. Tie a piece of string through the hole and now you are ready to go fly your kite!
