TEXAS SPIRIT THEATER



The Texas Spirit Theater is Austin's only multisensory special effects theater that immerses visitors in the film with crackling lightning, pounding rain, and a few other surprises.

The theater's three screens are set behind a generously sized stage that can be customized for film screenings, presentations, and live music. In-house shows include *Star of Destiny*, a 16-minute overview of Texas history, and *Shipwrecked*, a 26-minute, live-action reenactment of the story of *La Belle*. The Texas Spirit Theater can seat 190 guests.

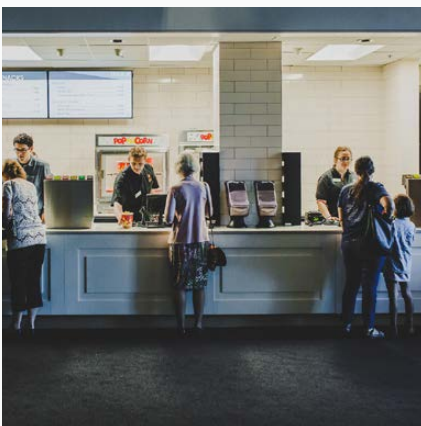

THEATERS FAQ

How do I book the theaters at the Museum?

To inquire about availability, please email Events@TheStoryofTexas.com. The Texas Spirit Theater and IMAX are available for rent alone or in conjunction with the rental of another event space.

When can I book the Texas Spirit Theater?

The Texas Spirit Theater is available for rental after 6:00 pm. Daytime availability is subject to approval.

When can I book the IMAX Theatre?

The IMAX Theatre can be rented in four-hour blocks of time. Availability is dependent on currently scheduled features and tickets sold. Please inquire for specific availability.

Please note that we are not able to accommodate private theatre buyouts on opening weekends of feature films.

When can we start setting up?

For evening rentals, access time begins at 4:30 pm. For daytime rentals, access time will be determined by Events Staff.

What services are included?

Our theater rental rates include a four-hour time frame, an on-site Museum Event Coordinator, and an in-house Theaters Team Member.

What can we show?

The Texas Spirit Theater can show screenings of the *Star of Destiny* and *Shipwrecked*, Bullock Films originals. The Texas Spirit Theater can also show multimedia presentations, live performances, and panel discussions.

The IMAX Theatre can show screenings of our current feature films and documentaries, or your own media. The space is also great for private film screenings, product launches, and multimedia presentations.

Are discounts available?

A 20% discount is available for nonprofit organizations, local state and government entities, and University of Texas clients. The discount is only applicable for Texas Spirit Theater rentals booked Sunday through Thursday.

Do we need insurance to book the theaters?

Yes, the Museum requires all private clients to provide a certificate of liability insurance with the Museum named as additional insured at least 30 days prior to the event.

What if I need to reschedule or cancel my event?

The Museum allows clients to reschedule an event up to 30 days prior to the contracted event date. Within 30 days of the event date, there is a \$250 rescheduling fee, and the date change must be approved by the Museum Event Staff.

Cancellations 90 days or more prior to the contracted event date are eligible for a deposit refund. Within 90 days, canceling will result in the forfeiture of the deposit.

Can we use our own equipment?

The Museum allows clients to use personal AV equipment in the Texas Spirit Theater for an additional \$500 fee.

Can we use an outside AV vendor?

Yes, the Museum allows the use of outside AV vendors from our preferred AV provider list.

Can we rehearse in the Theaters?

Concert or custom rentals in the Texas Spirit Theater include a two-hour rehearsal with prior coordination through Events and Theaters Staff. Additional rehearsal time can be arranged in advance for \$150 per hour and is subject to theater availability.

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THEATERS FAQ

Can we eat or drink in the theaters?

Yes, food and beverages are permitted in the theaters with prior approval from Event Staff. All food and beverage services must be provided by the Museum's concessions or our designated caterer.

Can merchandise be sold at an event?

Any sale of merchandise is not permitted on Museum property. With prior coordination, the Museum Store can remain open during an event for an additional cost, subject to approval.

Does the Museum have parking?

Complimentary parking is available for guests after 5:00 pm in the Museum's parking garage the day of the event. The capacity of the parking garage is 400 vehicles.

Daytime parking for event guests is available in the Museum's parking garage at the daily rate posted at the entrance, subject to availability and capacity.
